Research Analysis

SB 320 adds a member, appointed by the Governor, to the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth (OCCY) who has knowledge of, and experience with, Indian Child Welfare. The bill directs the Commission to establish procedures for monitoring grants awarded and authorizes it to refer programs and initiatives funded by those grants to the state auditor for an audit. Finally, the measure extends the term of office for postadjudication review board members from three to five years.
