**Research Analysis**

SB 365 creates the Oklahoma Driving Automation System Uniformity Act. The measure preempts local laws and asserts that only the State may enact laws or regulations regarding the use of motor vehicles equipped with driving automation systems in Oklahoma. The measure defines “driving automation system” and “dynamic driving task.”
