## **Research Analysis**

SB 400 allows a board of county commissioners to construct or maintain streets of a municipality with population between 5,000 and 15,000 in a county with population less than 150,000, as long as that municipality has passed a sales tax or fee with proceeds earmarked to street construction and improvement. The measure also clarifies the ability of county commissioners to construct or maintain streets in a municipality if the county's population is over 150,000.
