SB 419 requires licensed health care professionals that provide pre- and post-natal care to women and infants and hospitals that provide labor and delivery services to provide education to women and, if possible, their families about perinatal mental health disorders.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 419 allows the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision, the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners and the State Board of Nursing to work with hospitals and licensed health care professional to develop information, policies and educational materials related to perinatal mental health disorders. The language is permissive, therefore there is no fiscal impact. Any costs associated with the measure would be funded by existing revenues from each of the non-appropriated agencies.
