Research Analysis

SB 489 authorizes members of the State Board of Examiners of Certified Courtroom Interpreters to serve more than two terms in succession. Additionally, the Chief Justice may authorize other individuals to serve as Board members upon the Board's recommendation. Duties of the Board are modified. The measure further authorizes the Board to revoke the license of an interpreter that misrepresents credential status or violates other requirements and provides greater flexibility to the Board with regards to determining levels of interpreter credentialing standards.
