**Research Analysis**

SB 551 changes the requirement that the Department of Wildlife Conservation approve importation of cervidae originating in a county or Canadian province where Chronic Wasting Disease exists. The measure omits the agency approval, but requires that the State Veterinarian notify the agency of the importation.
