Amendment 1 to SB 622 would allow certain participation in the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System (OPPRS). The amendment is not expected to have an actuarial impact on the pension system.

**Other Considerations**

Under the procedures and provisions of the Oklahoma Pension Legislation Actuarial Analysis Act (OPLAAA), the amendment in its current form has been deemed a non-fiscal retirement bill amendment by the Legislative Actuary, meaning the bill, including the amendment, neither grants a benefit increase, adds actuarial liability, nor increases the normal cost of the retirement system affected.
