SB 71 provides that if the Board on Judicial Compensation recommends a change in judicial compensation, notice of the recommendation is to be provided to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore and the Chair of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate, and the Speaker and the Chair of the Appropriations and Budget Committee of the House of Representatives.

Fiscal Analysis

SB 71, which requires the Board on Judicial Compensation to notify the Governor, President Pro Tempore, House Speaker, and both Chairs of Appropriations and Budget of any recommendations to change judicial salaries, has no fiscal or revenue considerations for the state. The measure does not specify in what manner the Board must notify the above persons.
