**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for SB754 requires 25 percent of medical marijuana sales tax proceeds that exceed the budgeted amount for running the regulatory agency to go to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services.

The measure also authorizes certified nurse practitioners to provide medical marijuana recommendations for medical marijuana patient licenses under the authority of a supervising Oklahoma physician.
