**Research Analysis**

The Committee Substitute to SB 804 authorizes mixed beverage or beer and wine licensees to permit a patron to exit the licensed premises with an open container of beer or wine if the act occurs between 8:00 a.m. to midnight on the day of a scheduled home football game of institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education or the licensee is participating in a municipally sanctioned art or music event within city limits. The patron must remain on the connected property of the licensee or in a public area adjacent to the physical property of the licensee with prior municipal approval; provided that written notice of the use of the connected, physical property of the licensee or public area shall be provided to the ABLE Commission at least five days prior to such use.
