**Research Analysis**

SB887 authorizes counties to collect fees from medical marijuana licensees or caregivers who exceed maximum medical marijuana possession limits. The measure requires any authority granted by a county to a medical marijuana licensee or caregiver to exceed maximum possession limits to apply only within the borders of the county.
