Bill Analysis

HB 1182 requires medical licensing boards to revoke the license of any physician who performs an abortion, excepting cases in which the life or physical well-being of the mother is endangered. The performance of an abortion on the basis of the mental or emotional health of the mother shall be grounds for denial or revocation of a medical license. The measure also requires the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision and the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners to assess a \$500.00 fine on any physician licensed to practice medicine in the state if he or she participates in the performance of an abortion. The Boards are also directed to suspend the license of such physician for 1 year.
