**Floor Substitute (FS)**

The FS for HB 2468 creates the Oklahoma Gestational Agreement Act. The measure allows women to enter into an agreement to become pregnant with the genetic child of one or more intended parents and/or donors. A carrier must be at least 21 years of age, have given birth to one child, been a resident of Oklahoma for at least 90 consecutive days, and completed physical and mental medical evaluations.

The measure limits the parties of a gestational agreement to the carrier, carrier's spouse if applicable, and each intended parent of a child. Illegal immigrants may not be a party to a gestational agreement. Any gestational agreement must be in writing and comply with certain provisions outlined in the measure.
