## **Bill Analysis**

SB 1009 directs that a payment shall be made to a designated successor or, if one is not identified, the surviving spouse of a member of the Oklahoma Police Deferred Option Plan if the member is deceased. The amount of the payment shall be equal to the balance of an individual member's Oklahoma Police Deferred Option Plan. If no spouse or successor is identified, the balance shall be paid to the deceased member's estate. The measure also removes the requirement for the spouse to have been married to the member for thirty months when the participant dies while in and as a consequence of the performance of duties.
