**Bill Analysis**

SB 1125 modifies the qualifications for a teacher to receive an out-of-state certificate. The measure directs the State Board of Education to issue a teaching certificate to a person who holds a valid out-of-state teaching certificate, with no other requirements except a criminal history record check.
