Bill Analysis

SB 1299 directs the State Department of Education to designate a school district or charter school site as a Purple Star School if the site meets certain qualifications as outlined in the measure beginning with the 2021-2022 school year.

To implement and administer the program, SDE anticipates that the school district will submit an application to SDE for designation as a purple star campus. SDE staff will review and evaluate the application and make a determination if the school district meets the criteria and qualifies for the designation. SDE believes that it will need a .5 FTE at a program specialist grade to administer the program. The school districts may also incur cost to meet the requirements stated in the bill including among other things maintaining a website, maintaining a transition program and offering professional development.
