**Bill Analysis**

SB 1317 creates the State Tribal Education Data Partnership Act Between Tribes and the State of Oklahoma. The measure directs the State Department of Education to require school districts to submit additional data elements for students who identify themselves as American Indian or Native American in order to identify the tribe with which the student identifies or maintains tribal membership. The bill also modifies the term “student data” as it relates to the Student Data Accessibility, Transparency and Accountability Act of 2013 to include the changes made by the measure.
