**Bill Analysis**

SB 1320 directs a student to be considered in compliance with the residency requirements for school attendance if the parent or legal guardian of the student is transferred or is pending transfer to a military installation within the state while on active military duty. The measure directs school districts to accept enrollment applications for such students by electronic means and directs the parent or legal guardian of such a student to provide proof of residence to the school district within 10 days after the published arrival date. The measure defines what shall constitute proof of residence.
