Bill Analysis

SB 1400 modifies the term “unconcealed carry” to exclude carrying a firearm in the open hand. Such firearms must be holstered safely unless the user is hunting, at a gun range, or using the firearm for self-defense. The measure clarifies that pistols, handguns, rifles, shotguns and all other lawful firearms are defined as “firearms.”

The measure removes the administrative fine for loading a firearm with prohibited ammunition as well as the requirement for the Department of Public Safety to maintain a list of nonpermitting states.
