The CS for SB 1456 directs the Department of Corrections to make every reasonable effort to ensure that inmate case plans are achievable prior to an inmate's parole eligibility date, discharge date, or while the inmate is under supervised probation.

Directs DOC to make every reasonable effort to ensure that inmate case plans are achievable prior to an inmate's parole eligibility date, discharge date, or while the inmate is under supervised probation. Creates a new distinction: case plan compliance for achievement earned credits. Disallowing credits would cause certain inmates to serve day-for-day during their periods on noncompliance, increasing their days served.
