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Bill Analysis

SB 156 requires the State Board of Health to develop rules related to the establishment of minimum requirements for data collection for responses to time-sensitive medical conditions. Responses to stroke and ST-Elevated Myocardial Infarction (STEMI) incidents shall be subject to review by regional trauma advisory boards.

Additionally, the measure exempts regional trauma advisory boards from the provisions of the Open Meetings Act or discovery by subpoena if the meeting is conducted for the purpose of reviewing patient-specific care.

House Amendments

House Amendments to SB 156 replaces the State Commissioner of Health with the State Board of Health as it relates to developing rules for the establishment of minimum requirements.
