Committee Substitute (CS)

The CS for SB 1602 creates the Law Enforcement Unification Commission until December 1, 2021. The Commission is directed to study, evaluate, and make recommendations concerning the unification of public safety agencies within this state. The Commission shall be comprised of the directors of state law enforcement agencies as well as two members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and two members appointed by the Speaker of the House. Members of the Commission shall receive travel reimbursements, but no other form of compensation. The Commission must provide a report on its findings no later than February 1, 2021, to the Legislature.

Creates the Law Enforcement Unification Commission comprised of directors/designees from various law enforcement agencies. Members will not be compensated except for travel reimbursement. Meetings required at least quarterly. Directs OMES to provide staffing. The 2020 IRS standard mileage rate is 57.5 cents per mile.
