**Bill Analysis**

SB 1605 clarifies that policies related to firearm regulations are also preempted by the state. Persons aggrieved by a municipality, political subdivision of the state, or agency that violate the provisions of this measure are entitled to reasonable expenses if the court rules in favor of the plaintiff. If the court rules in favor of the municipality, political subdivision of the state, or agency, then the defendant is entitled to an award of reasonable expenses
