Bill Analysis

SB 1682 preempts any local regulations or rules relating to businesses and occupations licensed, regulated and controlled under the supervision of the Department of Consumer Credit. The measure prohibits any municipality or political subdivision from regulating the scope and practices of such licensees, the registration process, interest rates, and the physical location of such businesses. Local governments are also prohibited from disincentivizing such licensees. The measure provides for a person whose rights are violated to bring a civil action against the persons, municipality, and political subdivision jointly and severally for injunctive relief or monetary damages. The measure provides for municipalities and subdivisions to regulate certain aspects of licensees related to building codes, public health, and the collection of taxes.
