**Bill Analysis**

SB 1805 modifies the powers and duties of the Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools. The measure authorizes the Board to develop applications for sustained licenses, develop and present optional training, conduct announced and unannounced site visits, invoice a travel fee for site visits, and collect data required to be reported to the U.S. Department of Education or any state or federal agency. The measure provides for schools accredited for consecutive years to obtain a sustained license and establishes fees for reviews of catalogs. The measure provides fees for review of documentation to be forwarded to the U.S. Department of Education or another state or federal agency. The fee for attending a school workshop or webinar is increased by the measure from \$100.00 to \$200.00. The measure provides fees for half-day and full-day optional training. It creates a fee for review of enrollment agreements. The measure also directs that the Board's base fees will increase by 5% each year for fiscal year 2021, fiscal year 2022, and fiscal year 2023.
