**Bill Analysis**

SB 182 authorizes school districts to enter into an agreement with a municipality to establish a youth court. The court will be comprised of students in grades eight through twelve who completed training in the law, courtroom conduct and trial procedure. District attorneys and municipal court judges may assign cases involving juveniles under the age of eighteen who are charged with first-time misdemeanor or traffic offenses and who agree to participate and follow the sentencing guidelines of the youth court.
