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**Bill Analysis**

SB 196 lowers the minimum amount of time that a sheriff's office must maintain audio and visual recordings for at least one year that depict or relate to an officer related shooting, use of lethal force, incidents resulting in medical treatment, incidents identified in an application requesting retention of the recording, and incidents identified by the district attorney.

Additionally, the measure also requires an application identifying a specific incident for retention to be filed within ninety days of the recording. The measure also requires the sheriff's office of each county that utilizes audio or visual equipment attached to its officers to establish a video retention schedule that does not include any of the incidents listed above.

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
