Bill Analysis

SB 227 creates the Oklahoma Information Services Department Act. The measure creates the Oklahoma Information Services Department which will assume the responsibilities of the Information Services Division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. The measure consolidates all personnel, assets, purchase orders, and financial obligations of the Division under the newly created Department.

The measure sets the salary for the Chief Information Officer (CIO) at a range between \$130,000.00 and \$160,000.00. The CIO will be appointed by the Governor and serve at the Governor's pleasure. Additionally, the measure enumerates the qualifications needed for a person to serve as the CIO. The CIO will oversee the newly created Department for state agencies. Additionally, the CIO must establish, implement and enforce policies and procedure for the development and procurement of an interoperable radio communications system for state agencies and local governments.

The newly created Department will be subject to the Oklahoma Central Purchasing Act and other related purchasing acts for the approval and purchase of equipment and products not related to information and telecommunications technology. The measure also creates the Oklahoma Information Services Department Revolving Fund. The Fund will consist of all monies received by the Department.
