Bill Analysis

SB 238 requires any product containing cannabidiol to contain a label showing the country of origin and whether the cannabidiol is synthetic or natural. The measure states that the measure shall not apply to any pharmaceutical product approved by the Food and Drug Administration. Additionally, the measure exempts sellers of hemp and hemp products from licensure requirements if the hemp used in the products were legally grown and cultivated. Adding hemp and hemp products to cosmetics, personal care products and products intended for human or animal consumption shall be permitted without a license and shall not be considered an adulteration of such products.

House Amendments

House Amendments to SB 220 add a provision allowing those selling hemp and hemp products to sell such products and add such products to other goods without a license.
