Bill Analysis

SB 267 directs each school district, if funding is available, to install and maintain a panic button system. The system must connect the caller to a 911 operator, be available for use from a smartphone or similar device, and be limited to authorized users. The Oklahoma School Security Institute must provide a way for a public school to geo-fence the school campus and provide and manage floor plans and other documents to assist emergency responders. Additionally, the Institute must provide the training associated with the system.

Subject to availability of funding, each school district in this state shall have a panic button alert system.

Per the State Department of Education, vendor pricing ranges from around \$1500-\$6000 per school site. There is also a monthly monitoring/maintenance fee of around \$30.
