**Bill Analysis**

SB 300 creates the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency Limited Liability Act. The measure provides health care providers with immunity from civil liability for any loss or harm to a person with a suspected or confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19 caused by an act or omission by the facility or provider that occurs during the COVID-19 public health emergency, provided the act or omission was not the result of gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct. The provisions of the measure shall remain in effect until October 31, 2020, or until such time as the Governor affirmatively concludes the emergency declarations.
