**Bill Analysis**

SB 341 requires warrants issued for the arrest of a person in connection to a misdemeanor offense to contain an expiration date. The measure stipulates that the warrant will expire after three years or after such time has passed that the statute of limitations has expired, whichever comes first. The measure retroactively applies to outstanding warrants issued before the effective date.
