**Bill Analysis**

SB 409 directs the courts to waive all outstanding fees and fines if the offender has secured admission to, is enrolled in, and is actively pursuing completion in a program of study in a higher education institution, workforce training center, or a technology center. The court is further directed to waive fines and fees calculated off of the equivalent value of the potential gross income of the offender as established by the minimum wage rate of the state for each forty hour work week.
