**Bill Analysis**

SB 41 creates a task force which shall oversee an assessment and analysis of existing laws, policies, and practices relating to sentencing throughout the criminal justice process. The task force must submit its findings to the Governor, President Pro Tempore, and Speaker by November 30, 2020. The task force recommendations will focus on:

- 1) Sentencing and sentencing enhancements
- 2) Reducing recidivism and increasing success for those under probation and parole supervision
- 3) Improving access to reliable data

The task force will be comprised of 13 members and is subject to the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act.
