**Bill Analysis**

SB 431 changes the requirement for a person to identify whether they are carrying a firearm to a law enforcement official. Current law requires the person state they are in possession of a firearm during the course of any arrest or routine traffic stop. The measure changes this requirement to only require the person to state they are in possession of a firearm upon the demand of a law enforcement officer.
