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**Bill Analysis**

SB 452 directs school districts to consider restorative practices instead of out-of-school suspension for students who assault school personnel. Restorative practices include community service, requiring the student to apologize, assessment for mental health, and referrals to mental health professionals. Restorative practices must be available to all students of the district. School districts must provide for a student's reengagement if suspension or alternative school settings are utilized. The measure also requires school districts to create a threat assessment for a student convicted of a violent crime.

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
