**Bill Analysis**

SB 46 removes language prohibiting a convicted felon, person serving on probation, or any person previously adjudicated as a delinquent child or a youthful offender in the commission of a felony crime if that person was an adult from riding in a vehicle as a passenger if there is a firearm in the vehicle. The measure also strikes any reference to sawed-off shotguns, machine guns, and the adjective “dangerous or deadly” as it applies to firearms.
