Bill Analysis

SB 484 provides for suits to be brought against a county by naming a county officer when it is alleged that such officer in his or her official capacity is liable to the plaintiff in an action not based in contract. Other suits may be brought against the county by naming the board of county commissioners. County officers may later be substituted by the courts into the case upon a motion made by any party and upon a showing that such county officer is better suited to represent and defend the county.
