**Bill Analysis**

SB 660 allows certain retailers who sell alcoholic beverages to provide samples of beer, wine and spirits to consumers on its licensed premises. The samples must be sold at the licensee's location, poured from the drink's original sealed container, offered to consumers twenty-one years or older, limited based on the beverage type, and consumed on the licensee's premise. The licensee must maintain certain records of the samples on a form prescribed by the ABLE Commission and maintain no more than six bottles of alcoholic beverages for sampling.
