**Bill Analysis**

SB 728 authorizes golf complexes to sell and serve wine and beer from a golf complex pro shop on its property in accordance with rules promulgated by the Alcohol Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission. The measure creates a golf complex beverage license. The license authorizes golf complexes to sell wine and beer in stores located on premises owned by the golf complex. Such stores must be located in counties that have authorized the sale of alcohol by the drink.

The holder of a golf complex license must purchase from a licensed wine wholesaler or beer distributor. Consumption of beer and wine shall be prohibited inside the actual premises of the golf complex pro shop. The measure also defines various terms related to golf complex and golf courses.
