Committee Substitute (CS)

The CS for SB 742 requires the Office of Child Abuse Prevention to include in its annual report to legislative leaders statistics developed based on a report submitted by the State Department of Education detailing the number of instances in which students were convicted of truancy or detained. District attorneys and school districts will respectively submit a report detailing instances of truancy or detainment to the State Department of Education. The CS requires the Office or staff within the State Department of Health to review the submitted reports and provide an assessment of the family to determine if services should be offered or a referral for services should be made.
