**Bill Analysis**

SB 789 repeals the state's preemption on the minimum wage and minimum number of vacation or sick leave days, thereby allowing municipalities or other political subdivisions to establish a minimum wage rate or monthly minimum number of vacation or sick leave days within their jurisdiction.
