Bill Analysis

The CCS on SB 86 directs appropriated revenue provided to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (ODMHSAS) in the following manner:

- 1) ODMHSAS shall spend \$10 million of appropriated monies for Smart on Crime,
- 2) ODMHSAS shall spend \$1.7 million of appropriated monies on program growth,
- 3) ODMHSAS shall spend \$500,000.00 of appropriated monies on suicide prevention,
- 4) ODMHSAS shall spend \$1.9 million of appropriated monies for asbestos abatement of the Griffin Memorial Hospital located in Norman, Oklahoma, and
- 5) ODMHSAS shall spend \$500,000.00 to establish a pilot program to provide offenders incarcerated in county jails to evidence-based drug and alcohol treatment programs.

Additionally, the measure requires any increase in the Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) match rate to prioritize addressing the agency's maintenance needs first, addressing provider rates, and addressing caps in therapy and case management services. The Commissioner of the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services may request the early transfer of funds to alleviate cash-flow issues.

Conference Committee Report

The CCS on SB 86 substitutes the engrossed measure with the provisions described above.
