**Committee Substitute (CS)**

The CS for SB 86 amends the charge for a person convicted of assaulting any medical care providers to be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable up to one year of imprisonment. The measure amends the definition of medical care providers to include laboratory technicians, radiological technologists, medical students, physical therapists, physician assistants, chaplains, and hospital employees. The CS also increases the penalty for assaulting a provider performing medical care duties from up to one year of imprisonment to a maximum of two years of imprisonment.
