**Bill Analysis**

SB 892 authorizes physicians to issue one subsequent subscription for Schedule II controlled dangerous substance in a quantity not to exceed seven days if the prescription is made to a person that received a major procedure, the practitioner provides the subsequent prescription on the same day as the initial prescription, a “do not fill until” date is included, the subsequent prescription is dispensed no more than five days after the "do not fill until" date.
