## **Bill Analysis**

SB 922 creates Shannon's Law. The measure amends the definition of "health benefit plan." The measure defines health benefit plan to be any plan that provides benefits for a medical or surgical expenses incurred as a result of a health condition, accident or sickness and must be offered by an insurance company, group hospital service corporation, the State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board or health maintenance organization. The measure entitles any woman with a history of breast cancer or with a relative in the first degree with a prior history of breast cancer coverage for mammography screening. The measure lowers the age requirement to qualify for a screening from 35 to 30 and allows the screening to be annual.
