**Bill Analysis**

SB 930 states that any public trust may engage in activities outside of the geographic boundaries of its beneficiary if the activities benefit the beneficiary of a public trust. The measure also requires the public invitation to bid on a contract for the state or its subdivisions to be advertised at least once a week for two weeks in a newspaper. This provision only applies to contracts worth \$50,000.00 or more. Contracts for construction of public improvements shall be awarded pursuant to the Oklahoma Competitive Bidding Act of 1974.
