Bill Analysis

SB 967 directs the Criminalistics Services Division of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to develop a statewide electronic tracking system for evidence collection kits used to collect and preserve evidence of a sexual assault. The Division Director of the OSBI Crime Laboratory will oversee the system and ensure that untested sexual assault evidence collection kits are trackable and entered into the tracking system.
