## **Bill Analysis**

SB 995 requires poultry slaughtered by the raiser or custom-slaughter and exempted from the processing provisions of the Oklahoma Poultry Products Inspection Act to bear a label prescribed by the measure. The measure also grants exemptions from the provisions of the Act to producers that slaughter poultry raised by the producer and producers that sell poultry directly to consumers. These producers must slaughter fewer than 20,000 poultry per year or slaughter or process poultry products at a facility used for slaughtering or processing poultry products by any other person and affix the label prescribed by this measure. The measure further exempts small enterprises and does not require small enterprises to affix the prescribed label.
