Bill Analysis

SJR 15 refers to the people a constitutional amendment to allow members of the Legislature to be appointed or elected to other state positions in the State if the member is no longer in the Legislature. Current law prohibits a member of the Legislature from serving in an appointed office during the term for which elected and, in some cases, for two years afterwards.
